- Adult
- Young Adult, 15-21
- Junior, to 14 years

RULES: Pie Drop-off 2 PM, Judging 2:30 PM

1. Exhibitors do not need to be residents of Newport to compete.
2. Pies may be Dessert or Savory, but crust and filling must be homemade
3. Pie must be a minimum of 10" in diameter.
4. Exhibitor must bring the opened bag of King Arthur Flour or submit a UPC label from the flour bag when he/she submits the entry.
5. An entry form must accompany the entry.
6. Exhibitor must provide a legible recipe with the entry, preferably typed. Winning recipes may be published in local newspapers and provided to King Arthur Flour.
7. All entries must be submitted on a disposable container for judging.
8. All entries will be sold off by slice after judging, with proceeds going to the designated charity.
9. Pies will be judged by these criteria:
 - Presentation and creativity 20 Points
 - Crust 30 Points
(flavor and texture - flaky, tender, properly done including bottom crust)
 - Flavor 30 Points
(flavor, consistency, and appropriate fill level)
 - Overall Taste 20 Points
10. Failure to follow the rules may result in disqualification.
11. NEKHC and King Arthur Flour are not responsible for replacing lost or misplaced prizes or ribbons (including gift cards).
12. The entered pies become the property of the Pie Contest and that you do not get your pie or pie pan back.
13. If you are a winner, you give your permission to have your photo taken during the announcement ceremony and have it used for Pie Contest promotional materials, including the NEKHC Web site, newspapers, and other media.
14. If you wish to bake a pie and not have it judged, we will be happy to accept it and sell it to raise funds for the Halo Foundation.
